## WI 4-H International Programs:

**Emphasize** the value of 4-H and similar programs throughout the world.

**Give** 4-H'ers the chance for a cross cultural experience they will always treasure.

**Provide** the opportunity to know and appreciate another people and their culture.

**Help** individuals better understand themselves and their own culture.

**Develop** the potential of the world's most valuable resource: *its young people.*



## EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

WI 4-H International offers exchange programs to **Costa Rica, Finland, Japan, Korea, and Norway!**

Wisconsin 4-H youth between the ages of **12-18** have an amazing opportunity to stay with and become a part of a host family, experiencing daily life and culture firsthand for one month in the summer.

Delegates travel in groups with a chaperone to their host county where they participate in orientation and cultural activities before being welcomed by their host families

While abroad, 4-H'ers learn about their host country's culture while sharing about their own. At the end of the month, delegates return home with friendships and memories that last a lifetime.

**COST** Estimated at \$2,800 - \$5,200

Participants are responsible for all costs WI 4-H requires that at least \$1,000 be raised through individual fundraising with a local International Programs Committee; the participant pays the balance.

An optional 4-week intensive Nihongo (Japanese language) program can be added to Japan exchanges.

## HOSTING

Are you ready to welcome the world into your home??

This is a unique opportunity for all 4-H families to host a visitor from another country- urban, suburban, and rural!

During the summer, WI 4-H families welcome 12-17 year old Argentine, Costa Rican, Finnish, Japanese, Korean, Mexican, and Norwegian delegates into their homes for one month (July-August).

Families learn about another culture while sharing their own lives through meals, events, holidays, games, chores and more.

Opportunities also exist for hosting Eurasian or Japanese students for the school year. Students between the ages of 15-18 study in Wisconsin high schools while living with a host family for ten months to improve their English, learn about American culture, and become part of an American family and community.

## APPLICATIONS

Applications for *exchange* are due *December 1<sup>st</sup>*.

*Hosting* applications are due in late winter/early spring.
