



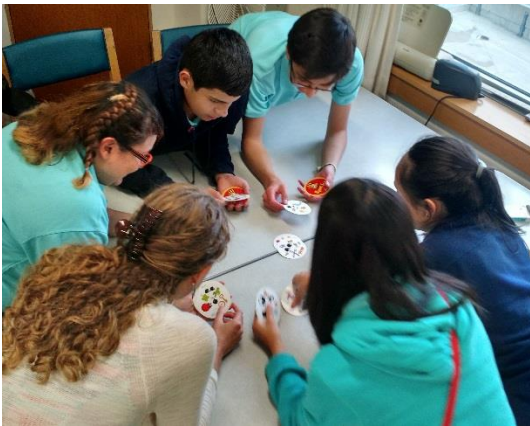
Host an international youth delegate and open the world!

- Youth have a range of English language abilities, host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively
- Youth ranging in age from 10

HOST FAMILY REQUIREMENTS

- You must have a child of the same gender and within 3 years of the hosted youth's age
- Families without children of the appropriate age may host an adult chaperone
- No special activities need to be planned, these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family
- Volunteer to participate in the program
- You do not need to be involved with 4-H to host
